## TERROIR CORBIERES AOP CORBIERES

### PRESENTATION

Driven by a passion for the Mediterranean lifestyle, Gérard Bertrand is the owner of reference estates in the South of France and reveals the unique expression of the 'Terroirs' of the region.

The terroir of Corbières reaches out from La Montagne Noire all the way to the Pyrenees encompassing a "patchwork-quilt like" variety of quality soils which were awarded their own AOC status in 1985.

### GRAPE VARIETIES

Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre

### WINEMAKER'S NOTES

On the vineyard the work starts with a selection of the vine plots best suited to producing this type of wine.

Most of the grapes are picked by hand. They are sorted twice, on the vine and then in the winery.

Vinification is traditional and the grapes are de-stemmed prior to maceration, which lasts between three and four weeks. Pressing is then carried out, followed by malolactic fermentation.

33% of the wine is matured in barrels for 9 months, with the rest left in vats.

### TASTING NOTES

The robe is dense and concentrated.

The nose is complex, with aromas of dark fruits, due to the exceptional grapes' maturity.

Terroir Corbières is a wine of character with flavours of ripe fruits, spices and a note of liquorice.

This cuvee is elegant, with a great depth and full body.

Enjoy this wine at 18°C with grilled red meats, tagines, tews and mature cheese.
